Open to male singers of all ages, Measure for Measure: A Men's Choral Society was founded in 1988 to provide an opportunity for singers to perform music composed and arranged for male voices. If you love to sing and can read music, come and see what we are all about.

The Measure for Measure 2009-10 season includes performances with the Bowling Green State University Men's Chorus, Wayne State University Concert Chorale, and tours to Indiana, Ohio, and northern Michigan, in venues including Hill Auditorium and the Ford Community and Performing Arts Center.

Participation in Measure for Measure remains open to all by audition, held in September and January of each year.

The content of a Measure for Measure audition is as follows:

Vocalization

The singer will perform a series of vocalization exercises to determine the range and color of the voice.

Sightreading

The singer is given a short excerpt from TTBB selection, and is asked to sing their part while the other three parts are played by an accompanist.

Interview

A short, informational interview is held with the M4M Board to provide more details about the ensemble.

Planning for an audition:

- * Prospective members are strongly encouraged to attend rehearsal from 6:30-9:00PM, with auditions immediately following. All rehearsals and auditions are held in Alexander Hall 109, on the campus of Eastern Michigan University.

Singers are notified of results after the completion of all auditions.
